NOTES:

1. Percentages are not calculated when the total number of records in the data group (or the denominator) is less than 10.
2. Out of the 28 students who took the Calculus BC test without enrollment in an appropriate AP course, 22 were enrolled in a community college Calculus course. The Calculus AB Subscore Grade is based on performance on the portion of the Calculus BC test devoted to Calculus AB topics.
3. Out of the 56 students who took the US History test without enrollment in an appropriate AP course, 22 were at SD/International Studies and took the History of the Americas IB course while 16 took the honors level US History and Geography course.
4. Out of the 82 students who took the Spanish Language test without enrollment in an appropriate AP course, 76 had a primary language of Spanish.
