1. Percentages are not calculated when the total number of records in the data group (or the denominator) is less than 10.
2. Out of 35 Calculus BC test takers without enrollment in an appropriate AP course, 28 were enrolled in a community college calculus course. The Calculus AB Subscore Grade is reported based on performance on a portion of the Calculus BC test.
3. Out of 28 Calculus AB test takers without enrollment in an appropriate AP course, 21 were enrolled in an IB calculus course.
4. Out of 42 English Literature and Composition test takers without an appropriate AP course, 20 took honors literature coursework.
5. Out of 56 Spanish Language test takers without enrollment in an appropriate AP course, 55 had a primary language of Spanish.
