2. Out of 30 Calculus $B C$ test takers without enrollment in an appropriate AP course, 16 were enrolled in a community college calculus course and 12 were enrolled in AP Calculus $A B$. The Calculus $A B$ Subscore Grade is reported based on performance on a portion of the Calculus $B C$ test.
3. Out of 12 Calculus $A B$ test takers without enrollment in an appropriate AP course, 8 were enrolled in the first semester AP Calculus AB course.
4. Out of 44 English Language and Composition test takers and 36 English Literature and Composition test takers without an appropriate AP course, 32 took honors literature coursework.
5. Out of 113 Spanish Language test takers without enrollment in an appropriate AP course, 102 had a primary language of Spanish.
6. Some district schools offer 9th graders the opportunity to take AP courses and exams. In 2009-10, there were 368 AP tests taken by Grade 9 students; most are from Mira Mesa, Point Loma, and University City and most took Human Geography or Environmental Science. The 9th grade exam pass rate for Human Geography was 36 percent; 46 percent for Environmental Science.
