Cohort Graduates - The number of students in the "Class of" cohort who graduated **within four years or less**. The cohort graduation rate is calculated by dividing the number of students in the cohort who graduate in four years or less with either a traditional high school diploma, an adult education high school diploma, or have passed the California High School Proficiency Exam (CHSPE) by the number of students who form the [adjusted] cohort for that graduating class.

The [adjusted] cohort includes students who enter 9th grade for the first time in the initial year of the 4-year period, and is then adjusted by: adding students who later transfer into the cohort during grade nine (year 1), grade 10 (year 2), grade 11 (year 3) , and grade 12 (year 4); and subtracting students who transfer out, emigrate to another county, or die during the 4-year period. All other students remain in the cohort.

All Graduates - All students who graduated during the school year, and includes on-time, early, and late graduates. Graduates includes students who received a traditional high school diploma or an adult education high school diploma.
